Great Horse Manure Crisis of 1894:

- London 50.000 horses, Paris 80.000, NY 100.000
- 15 and 35 pounds of manure and 2 pints of urine per day per horse
- huge numbers of flies which spread typhoid fever and other diseases, carcasses in the streets
- The Times article 1894 predicted... “In 50 years, every street in London will be buried under nine feet of manure.”
- 1898 at the world’s first international urban planning conference in New York, but no solution could be found. Seemed urban civilization was doomed
- Necessity is the mother of invention, not to despair, something turns up!
- Trust that the eco system does its job
